Cougars and Black Bears In Washington State

TENINO, WA- On Earth Day, [Wolf Haven International](http://WolfHavenInternational.org) will present the third and final lecture in their [Speakers Series](#) with a presentation about cougars and black bears in Washington State. [Donny Martorello](#), Carnivore, Furbearer, and Special Species Manager for Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife, will speak on Earth Day, [Wednesday, April 22](#), from 7:00 - 9:00 p.m. at Great Wolf Lodge in Grand Mound.

While pursuing his graduate and post-graduate degrees, Donny worked with black bears in coastal North Carolina and the Great Smoky Mountains. He has worked for Fish and Wildlife for the past 9 years.

Martorello will share research findings about black bears and cougars and how science and management can be successfully linked in the cause of wildlife management.
