Wolf Haven offers small group visits with our education team during the week (typically on Thursdays) to help you reach your learning goals! Each experience is structured around the specific groups' needs and goals.

Onsite programs include options of taking a guided visit through the sanctuary, walking on the prairie, and exploring age/subject-appropriate educational components. We offer multiple presentation and activity topics, covering subjects like:

- wolf basics
- wolf history in the Pacific Northwest and North America
- predators
- ecosystems
- and more!



STEM Kits

One possible educational component option is our STEM kits, which can be completed onsite with Wolf Haven staff & volunteers.



- Wonder of Wolves: gain understanding about the role & effects wolves have in the ecosystem through a series of activities that incorporate social structure, behavior, diet, and diverse human perspectives.
 - 45-90 minutes, 6th-12th grade+

- Wolf Genetics: delve into the world of genetics, gaining understanding of how traits that are passed from parent to offspring affect the health and genetic diversity of a wolf population.
 - 90 minutes, 8th-12th grade+
- **Bees Please:** discover & exchange data from a citizen science project about different species of bees to explore biodiversity and behavior.
 - 45 -90 minutes, 4th- 12th grade+

A STEM kit is a box of activities and experiments designed specifically to teach scientific inquiry and the nature of science, paired with current research happening around the world! Wolf Haven's kits were designed in conjunction with and built by Colorado State University's Natural Sciences Education & Outreach Center.
