Wolf Haven International is seeking a Communications Intern to join our team! This position supports Wolf Haven's various communications activities, which can include **writing and editing, video production, graphic design, web development, social media, and/or other communications work** that engages a wide community of Wolf Haven supporters and stakeholders. This is a unique opportunity to gain practical experience with a great local nonprofit whose fun and dynamic team consists of 20 staff, over 50 volunteers, and many outstanding community friends and partners.

The workload may vary depending on the project and the unique skills and availability of the intern. Preferably, the Communications Intern would work **6-14 hours per week for a minimum of 3 months and up to an entire school year**. The exact timing of the work is flexible and can take place in-person, hybrid, or remote. Depending on the needs of the student, Wolf Haven and your university may be able to develop an independent learning contract to provide **academic credit or work study payments**.

The Communications Intern should have an **interest in wildlife, conservation, and science, with a desire to communicate with members of the public about Wolf Haven's mission**. They support the organization's various programs and help the organization to become more diverse, equitable, and inclusive.

Essential Functions

- Work with Wolf Haven's Communications Manager to implement a variety of outreach and communications projects
- Assist with social media marketing, including coordinating or developing content to share based on the social media calendar, monitoring pages for spam, and responding to comments & messages across platforms
- Work with conservation, education, and animal care staff to publish news updates through Wolf Haven blog posts, press releases, and e-newsletters that inspire people to take action
- Contribute ideas and a unique perspective to Wolf Haven's communications plan to help develop new and exciting ways to engage a growing audience
- Depending on the intern's technical skills and interests, the position can explore additional projects related to video production, web development, graphic design, and more

This position is tailored to individual applicants and will generally focus on one specific project rather than the full scope of Wolf Haven communications work. Projects areas could include (but are not limited to) **writing and editing, video production, graphic design, web development, social media, event planning, or marketing/public relations**. The end result of the project should revitalize Wolf Haven's communications or fill an important program gap.

The workload will vary depending on the unique skills and availability of the intern. Preferably, the project-based Communications Intern would work **6-14 hours per week for the duration of the project**. The exact timing of the work is flexible and can take place in-person, hybrid, or remote. Depending on the needs of the student, Wolf Haven and your university may be able to develop an independent learning contract to provide **academic credit or work study payments**.

The project-based Communications Intern should have an **interest in wildlife, conservation, and science, with a desire to communicate with members of the public about Wolf Haven's mission**.  - sort, upload, and edit historic *Wolf Tracks* articles for Wolf Haven's blog
 - process and label archival photo & video footage from various Wolf Haven servers
- **Merchandise**
 - work with the Visitor Center Coordinator to develop sustainable & eco-friendly merch using Wolf Haven's new logo, and propose new ways to market merchandise
- **Multimedia**
 - film, edit, and produce a new introductory "welcome video" for Wolf Haven's visitor center to play at the start of every visit
 - audit & organize Wolf Haven's YouTube channel for proper usage
- **Social Media**
 - analyze Wolf Haven's current social media content/distribution strategy and propose upgrades according to industry trends
 - research and develop a Patreon account
