VOLUNTEER ROLE

Goals of the role:

- Be the face of Wolf Haven first person visitors see when they arrive at the sanctuary for a visit
- Expand visitors' knowledge of wildlife adaptations and habitats

Impact of the role:

- Inspires people to protect all species and their environments
- Up to 2,500 visitors per year feel more informed and see a friendly face upon arrival

Responsibilities:

- Set up and take down educational booth and props
- Be available for visitors before and after visits
- Inform guests about props such as skulls/prints/scat and how they relate to ecology and biology
- Keep up with ongoing wolf news and updates
- Express Wolf Haven's views and opinions rather than your own

Time requirement:

- Minimum 1 shift per month (~3 hours)
- Minimum 1 year commitment

Qualifications:

- Comfortable speaking to individuals and small groups
- Willingness to learn and adapt
- Great communication skills
- Comfortable handling differing opinions with empathy and calm

Location & work environment:

- Wolf Haven's primary sanctuary in Tenino, WA
- Outside in various weather conditions, under covered area
- During winter months, the docent station may be moved inside the Visitor Center

- Learn about wolves and wolfdogs
- Merchandise discount
- Training opportunities on various subjects
- Meet people with similar interests

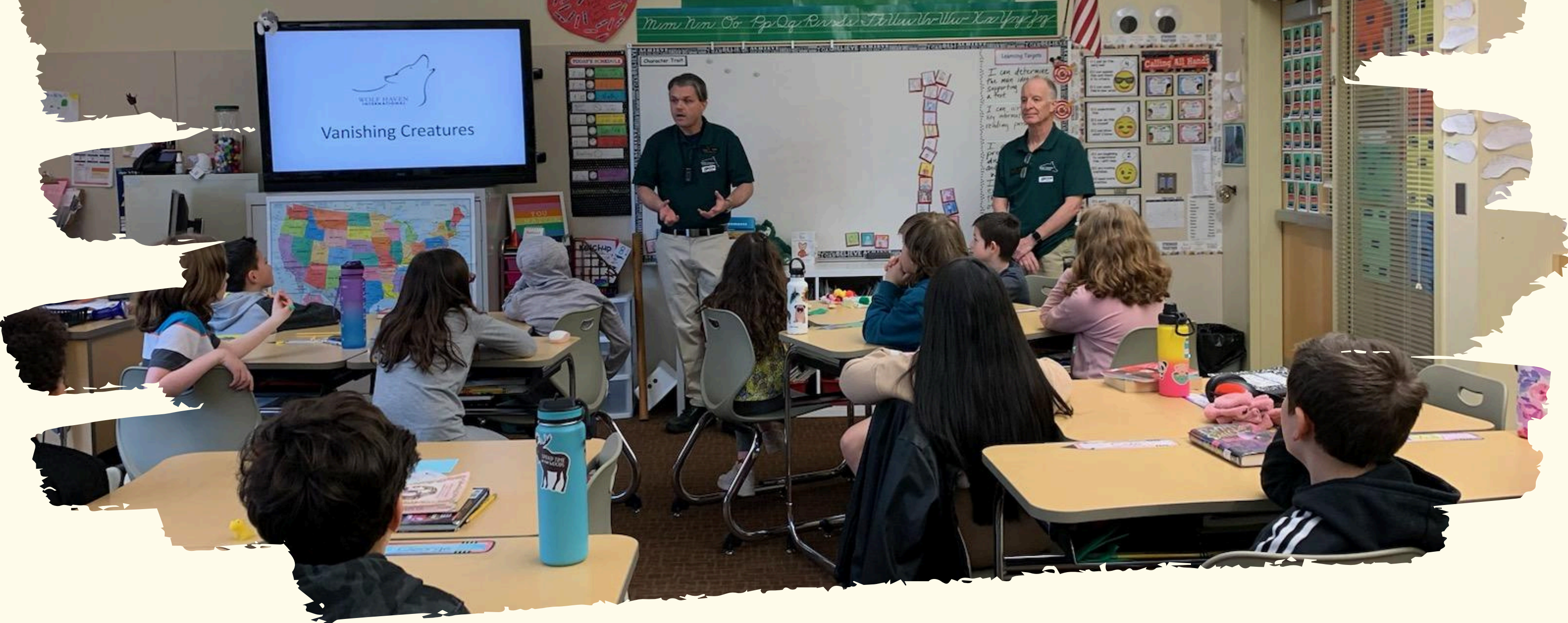

Goals of the role:

- Engage groups to get them excited about conservation

Impact of the role:

- Allows us to communicate with diverse audiences who may not have been aware of these topics or be able to come to the sanctuary

Responsibilities:

- Present programs to groups ranging from kindergarten to seniors citizens; topics vary based on age group
- Keep up with ongoing wolf news and updates
- Express Wolf Haven's views and opinions rather than your own

Time requirement:

- Minimum 1 shift per month (~2-4 hours)
- Minimum 1 year commitment

- Willingness to learn and adapt
- Great communication skills
- Comfortable handling differing opinions with empathy and calm
